

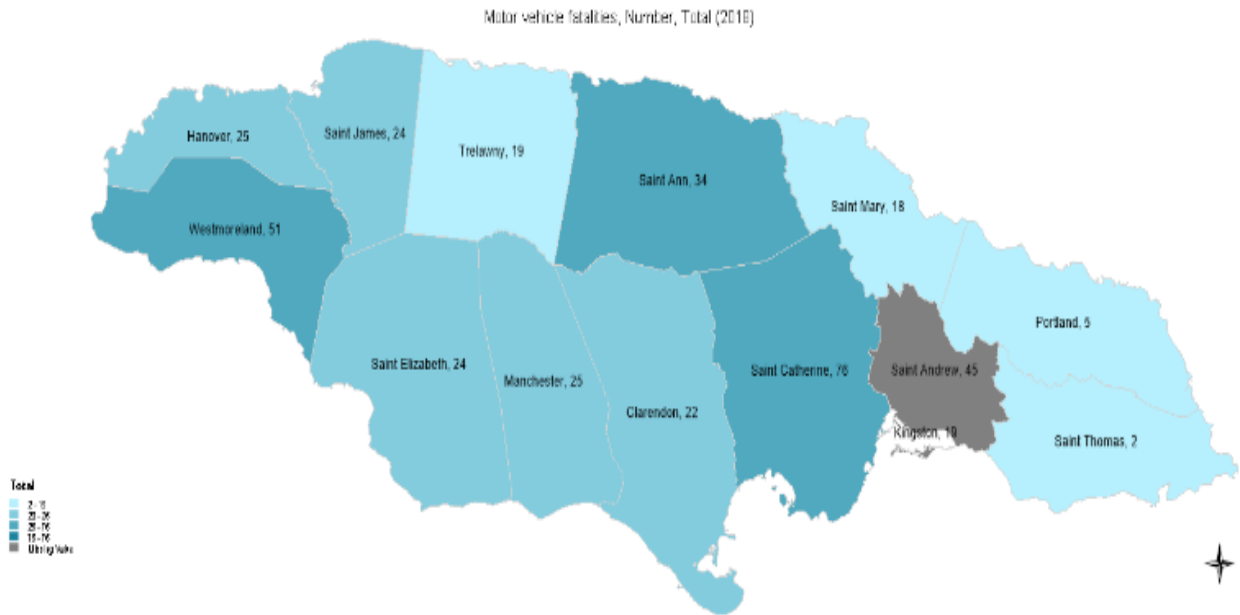
Motor Vehicle Fatalities by Parish

Definition: Motor vehicle fatalities refers to an incident which involves any Motor Vehicle collision along any public thoroughfare that leads to loss of life, whether the road is public or private and the crash involved at least one vehicle. The accident must have been reported to the police, and at the time of the crash, a motor vehicle must have been in motion.

Motor vehicle accidents are a major public health burden costing the Government of Jamaica millions of dollars per year. In 2017 and 2018 there were 323 and 389 fatalities respectively, with St Catherine accounting for the most deaths (approx. 20%) of any parish in 2018.
